## Checklist 19-2. Developing Use Areas

## Public Use Entrance and Front Areas

Identify strategies to accent entryway:
$\square$ Alter the pathway: widen or change surface
Add a featured plant
$\square$ Add a hardscape feature
$\square$ Add lighting
Assess house number visibility:
$\square$ Visible from a car driving both ways down street
$\square$ Visible traveling both ways on the sidewalk
$\square$ Visible at night
Evaluate how visitors enter the home:
$\square$ Adequate parking for visitors:
$\square$ Off-street - include in landscape with easy access to entry
$\square$ On-street - easy access to entry
$\square$ Pathway to front door:
$\square$ Wide enough
$\square$ Well lit
$\square$ Free from tripping hazards
$\square$ Entry area visible and well lit

## Private Use Family Activity Areas

Consider for outdoor entertainment space:
$\square$ Patio, deck, or terrace: $\qquad$

$\square$ Evaluate soil type
$\square$ Good drainage; no low spots where water accumulates
$\square$ Good air circulation
$\square$ Protection from heavy winds
$\square$ Near good location for a compost pile
$\square$ Close to the kitchen
$\square$ Out of major sight lines
$\square$ Close to potable water source
Consider for pets:
$\square$ Identify pet(s) use of landscape
$\square$ Adequate turf grass meet for pets' needs
